Pille Bunnell is a systems ecologist. She is a professor at Royal Roads University as well as an editor of *Cybernetics and Human Knowing* and *Constructivist Foundations*.

Bunnell has specialized in the integration and explanation of complex concerns for domain specialists, policy makers, students, and the public. She acted as the Director of Environmental Literacy with an international consulting firm (ESSA Technologies Ltd.) where she conducted integrative projects on Adaptive Environmental Management with concerns ranging from fisheries, to land use management and climate change. Over the last decade she has shifted her focus to cybernetics, and has been writing papers and books concerning the nature of complex systems and human cognition, and the practical applications of these fields to the multifaceted relations between humans and the biosphere.

Bunnell designed and co-authored the first State of Environment report for British Columbia, Canada, and developed public school curricula on ecology.
