

Raymond ISON

Raymond Ison is a professor of systems at The Open University UK, Milton Keynes. He is also Vice President of the International Federation for Systems Research, a Trustee for the American Society of Cybernetics, and Director of the World Organisation of Systems and Cybernetics.

Ison focuses on Systems scholarship that draws on second-order cybernetics and the biology of cognition and for developing the use of Mode-2 modalities of research practice. He has made significant contributions in the areas of systemic governance, systems practice and social learning, systemic environmental decision making, 'knowledge transfer', design of learning/inquiring systems and agricultural/food systems. His research has found practical application in diverse fields including water management, organizational change, staff induction, Higher Education reform and rural development.

Ison was awarded the Wesley College Foundation Medal by the University of Sydney in 2016.

Ison is the author, co-author or editor of 6 books, 9 journal special editions, 37 book chapters, and 137 refereed papers.
