Helena Knyazeva is a professor at the National Research University Higher School of Economics. She sits on the board of the Bertalanffy Center for the Study of Systems Science, the Association of Complex Thinking, the German Society of Complex Systems and Nonlinear Dynamics and the Russian Philosophical Society. Knyazeva is also an editor for *Ludus complexus: Revista Multiversitaria de complejidad*, *Praxema: Journal of Visual Semiotics*, *Complex Systems: An Interdisciplinary Scientific Journal*, and *Exploring Unity through Diversity*.

Knyazeva's fields of expertise include philosophy of complexity, synergetics, cognitive complexity, theory of innovations, and futures studies.

Knyazeva has authored about 450 publications, including 10 monographs and 21 peer-reviewed journal articles.

Knyazeva has been appointed to the Academic Council of the Multiversidad Mundo Real Edgar Morin and as a council member for the Darwin Project.
