

Michael Lissack is the current President of the American Society for Cybernetics (ASC http://asc-cybernetics.org).

For 20 years Dr. Lissack was the executive director of *the Institute for the Study of Coherence and Emergence* (ISCE). He presently is a *Professor of Design and Innovation at Tongi University (Shanghai)* and was the first Walter J. Hickel Professor at Alaska Pacific University. Dr. Lissack founded both a non-profit research institute and a charity for artists, launched an international PhD program in corporate anthropology, has written half dozen books, been a successful Wall Street banker, and a candidate for public office. He has taught at a number of academic institutions in the US and Europe, run sixteen international conferences on the topics of *explanation, complexity, management, health care, entanglement and ethics* and founded a successful academic journal (E:CO). Worth Magazine recognized Dr. Lissack as one of "Wall Street's 25 Smartest Players" in 1999 and as *one of the 100 Americans who have most influenced "how we think about money"* in 2001.
