Negoita's main research interests are fuzzy sets and systems. He was editor and founder first fuzzy sets and systems journal, *Fuzzy Sets and Systems*, with L.A. Zadeh and H.J. Zimmermann as well as author of the first textbook on fuzzy sets and systems, with D. Ralescu.

Negoita was honored as an Appointed Fellow with the International Fuzzy System Association in 2015. He was presented with a Doctor Honoris Causa from the University of Pitesti in 2000. He has also won the IEEE Award for New Technical Concepts in 1985.
