Bernard Scott is Gordon Pask Professor of Sociocybernetics at the International Center for Sociocybernetics Studies. He is also a member of the editorial advisory boards of the journals *Kybernetes*, *Cybernetics and Human Knowing*, *Campus-Wide Information Systems* and *Constructivist Foundations*.

While in school Scott worked with his supervisor, Gordon Pask, to develop “conversation theory” and associated cybernetic models of learning and teaching, build interactive learning environments and carry out extensive empirical studies of how humans learn.

Scott has authored over 130 publications.

Scott is a fellow and founder member of the U.K.'s Cybernetics Society, an Associate Fellow of the British Psychological Society, and a Fellow of the American Society for Cybernetics. The American Society for Cybernetics also awarded him the McCulloch Award in 2013.
